CHRIS MELHAM APPOINTED AS NEXT AUSTRALIAN TRUCKING ASSOCIATION CEO

Current CEO Stuart St Clair said the appointment would enable the ATA to continue its high level of advocacy and take its operations to a new level.

"Chris Melham's experience, professionalism and drive will enable the ATA to provide the leadership the industry needs," Mr St Clair said.

"I'm proud to have served the ATA and the trucking industry for the past 9 years as CEO, and to leave the ATA in a strong position. I know Chris will do a great job, and wish him all the best in the role."

Mr St Clair was appointed Chief Executive of the ATA in March 2006, and announced his impending retirement in June this year. He will officially hand over the role to Mr Melham at the Trucking Australia 2015 conference in Hobart on 19 - 21 March 2015.
